Each week during the summer, we need 15-20 volunteers to make camp run smoothly. As you may know, we run weekend retreats all throughout the Fall, Winter and Spring. So if you can't make it for the summer, we can always use help for other seasons.

**A.** Did you honestly expect to find that answer in a mere brochure? You need to search your heart and see what your motivation is. Do you really want to be used by God? Do you have a heart for reaching kids with the Gospel? Are you willing to serve in whatever capacity you are needed in order to answer God's call? To find out the answers to these questions and more, you need to spend time in prayer and ask God to tell you if He wants you at camp. # Summer Staff Team Q & A

## Am I qualified to be on SST?

All SST & volunteer staff members must:

- Be at least 18 years of age or high school graduates (*SST only*).
- Have accepted—by faith alone—Jesus Christ as their Savior, declared Him Lord of their lives, and be presently living out a consistent, Christ-honoring life.
- Be in an agreement with the LLBC statement of faith found at [www.lakelundgrenbiblecamp.org](http://www.lakelundgrenbiblecamp.org) (under About LLBC).
- Desire to live and grow as a Godly example in a ministry to young people.
- Be able to accept responsibility and to submit to authority.
- Be a positive contribution to the staff team both in attitude and performance.
- Be healthy and capable of hard work.
- Specific jobs may require previous staff experience or official certification/training.

## Will I make any money working at camp?

SST at Lake Lundgren is part of a missionary endeavor. All of our staff are required to raise missionary support, including SST members.

Compensation for the summer is as follows: You will be paid a stipend of \$900 for the full SST session of 10.5 weeks. You will need to raise additional financial support ranging from a minimum of \$1,200 to the maximum \$3,200, with the goal being at least \$1,700. Also remember that you have very little need to spend money while at camp, so you save a lot of it!

*In addition to financial compensation, you will receive room, board, training materials, love, friendship and a great reward in heaven.*

## What is "SST"?

Summer Staff Team members work with our year-round missionary staff and short-term volunteers to run camp during our full 9 weeks of summer programs (8 youth camps, and our family camps).

## What will I do?

You will be a part of our core group of staff and receive 10 days of staff training to prepare you for 9 weeks of ministry. You will use your gifts to serve over 1,400 people through our summer camping ministry! In reality you'll probably do a little of everything, and that will likely include some of the following:

Cabin Counselor, Lifeguard\*, Craft Instructor, Worship Team, Activity Staff, Custodian, Kitchen Cook and Dishcrew, Office Assistant, and Adventure Trip Assistant.

## Will I have to work hard?



Yes. SST is not your typical summer job. The summer schedule is incredibly demanding. You will be expected to work long hours with relatively few breaks. You will, however, come to love camp and the wonderful people you will get to know and serve.
