## Leadership Development Camp,

or LDC as it is frequently called, is an intensive ten-day program for students with leadership potential entering 10th—12th grades. During LDC, students are involved in studying God’s Word, memorizing Bible verses, receiving training to develop their servant leadership skills, and participating in leadership roles around camp. LDC takes place during regular youth camps, giving an excellent opportunity for students to interact with campers and staff and to experience leadership training firsthand.

### Qualifications for LDC 1

Applicants must:

- be entering 10th, 11th or 12th grade.
- have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord by faith alone and be presently living a consistent, Christ-honoring life.
- be able to accept responsibility and to submit to authority.
- desire to develop leadership skills.
- be capable of handling assignments.
- desire to serve God and His people.
- demonstrate leadership potential.
- be able to physically and mentally endure 10 straight days of high level activities & training.



## What is the difference between LDC 1 and 2?

LDC 1 is for 10th-12th graders entering the first year of the program. Students will be involved in discipleship and Biblical training, with an opportunity to practice what they learn.

LDC 2 is for 11th-12th graders entering the second year of LDC. Students who have successfully completed LDC 1 will receive an invitation to apply for LDC 2. During the second year program, students will actively participate in more advanced leadership shadowing roles, while still receiving Biblical training and discipleship.

### When are LDC 1 and 2?

**LDC 1a: July 9-18**

**LDC 1b: July 19-28**

**LDC 2b: June 25-July 6**

#### PLEASE NOTE:

**LDC 1** students will be staying for 10 straight days (including the weekend).

**LDC 2** students will be in session for the entire 12 days.

LDC1 Cost: \$270      LDC2 Cost: \$320

Cost includes lodging, meals, materials, training, LDC shirt and—for LCD 2—a special activity.
