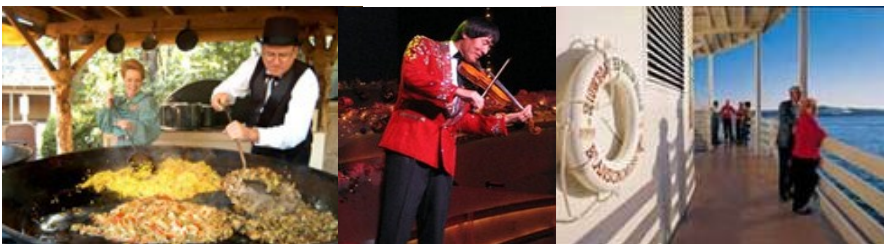
The price includes admission to feature attractions, deluxe restroom-equipped motor coach transportation, 6 nights' lodging in quality motels with deluxe continental breakfasts, our traditional first day box lunch, the shows and attractions, and one other choice meal per day. Baggage handling (**one** suitcase per person, please), snacks, devotionals, the services of your tour guides/nurses, and lots of fun are the icing-on-the-cake for our bus tours!

A deposit of \$100 per person must accompany your registration with the balance due by September 31, 2012. After that date only half of your fee will be refunded should you need to cancel. The overnight fee for staying at Lake Lundgren the night before or after the trip is available for \$15.00 per person per night in a cabin with a bath, and includes a cup of coffee and sweet bread to get you started for the day on Wednesday.

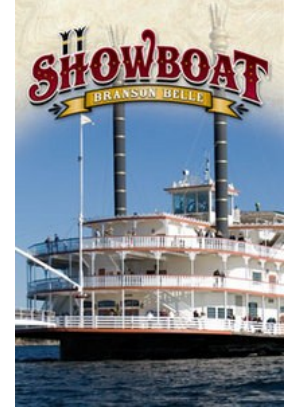
LLBC Bus Tour Schedule November 28—December 4, 2012
